Dear author of digital poster presentations

Thank you for submitting your work to the FFN Global Congress Oslo 2023. A digital poster allows your colleagues to study your work for as long as they wish and wherever they are. Your digital poster will be available through the Congress app, alongside the full text of your abstract with author list and all the text you submitted. Funding and potential conflicts of interest (COI) must be declared

The poster should thus be used to highlight important aspects of your work and improve the experience of reading your abstract. You may include the full text of your abstract in your poster, but that is not strictly necessary as it is available through the congress app.

When you design your poster, bear in mind that a lot of people will look at the poster on their phones. However, the app is also available on computers, and people can download your poster to view at any screen.

The format must be pdf. A4 portrait (W210 x H297 mm) size is recommended. You may use the attached PowerPoint template and save it as a pdf (In Office: Choose "save as", and then select "pdf" in the dropdown menu near the document title). However, you are free to make your poster in any format and then save it as a pdf before submitting. You may use more than one page.

We need the digital posters at least ten days before the Congress. Please email the pdf document as an attachment to Kristin Solstad, PCO at kristin@ksci.no. Please name the file with your abstract id, your last name and the first few words of your abstract title.
