The abstract content must be presented, including all authors, and contact information (e.g., email address, WhatsApp user, telephone number) for at least one author. In addition, funding and potential conflicts of interest (COI) must be declared. You are welcome to add images, tables, and detailed data to better document your work. Since there will be many other posters, you must make sure your poster is interesting and visually slick if you hope to attract viewers.

- The posters will have "portrait" format, Paper AO: height 1189 mm x width 841 mm (or 46.8 x 33.1 in), and in any case no larger than H120 x W90 cm. Please feel free to use the poster template at the end of this file if you find it useful.
- . Posters should be posted at the latest during the coffee break Wednesday morning and taken down after the lunch break Friday. We are trying to get enough space to keep all posters up during the whole Congress, but we may have to arrange a change of posters some time Thursday. You will be informed about that as soon as know. A map detailing where your poster should be placed will also be made available before the Congress.
- **Poster walks.** There will be organized poster walks during the lunch breaks covering all four pillars.
- **Best poster prize.** The jury will select posters eligible for the best poster prize based on the abstract, and the winners will be presented in a separate session during the Congress.







Graphs created in a scientific graphing program (e.g.. Sigma Plot, Prism, SPSS, Statistics) should be saved as JPEG or TIFF.




The body text / font size should be no smaller than 20 points. Try to keep body text left-aligned, do not justify text.

METHOD

Tips for making a successful poster...

- Re-write your paper into poster format i.e.. simplify everything, avoid data overkill.
- Headings of more than 6 words should be in upper and lower case, not all capitals. Simplify the titles.
- Try not to write whole sentences in capitals or underline to stress your point, use **bold** characters instead.
- When laying out your poster, leave white space around your text.
